Resolution No. 199 7 February 2013.

Bioethics Committee of Opole Chamber of Physicians in Opole, acting on the basis of the Regulation of the Minister of Health and Social Welfare of 11 May 1999. On the detailed rules for establishing and financing and the mode of operation of the ethics committee (Dz.U.Nr 47, poz.480), Code Medical ethics, taking into account the principles of the Declaration of Helsinki and Good Clinical Practice and the International Conference on Harmonisation of Technical Requirements for Registration of Pharmaceutical of Human Use (ICH) - at its meeting on 7 February 2013. noted the request for an opinion on the project, medical experiment made by the head of the subject:

A clinical study is entitled:

"Short-term and long-term effects of pulmonary rehabilitation."

The study included the following documents:

1. Description of the study.
2. Information on the conditions of insurance a person having to participate in the experiment
3. Data on the expected therapeutic benefit, and possibly cognitive and other expected benefits for persons subjected to the experiment.
4. Statements audited consent to participate in the study.
5. Consent for the implementation of research hospital MSW
6. insurance policy.

Bioethics Committee after hearing about the project submitted by Mrs Barbara Szczegielniak decided to allow the project to carry out a medical experiment.
